Born in Detroit, Michigan, Dr. Hanley was a graduate of Hillsdale College and received his doctorate in psychology from St. Louis University. He was a member of KRST Universal Temple, Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., the Association of Black Psychologists and the Association of Black Social Workers.
